



Bulk Regulations

for space 20ft and more in depth

In most bulk areas, backdrops are not permitted, expectations may be permitted in some cases, but written approval must be obtained by Show Management in advance. Special considerations are given to spectacular centerpiece displays.

- Floor Covering is recommended in common areas of bulk space footprint.
(Acceptable covering to be approved by Show Management)
- If constructing a booth, all back walls cannot exceed 8' and sidewalls 6' and must be finished on both sides, including product/s. Booth construction must be placed in the middle of the booth not on sides or corners blocking visibility of another exhibitor. These heights also refer to any exhibit material (towers, TV stands, built or curtained offices and products) located next to back or sidewalls that would block the sightline to a neighboring exhibit).
- All product and booth material must remain within the confines of your allocated booth space and square footage.
- Raised flooring should be beveled with caution taped for safety.
- Hand rendered signs are not permitted.
- If you wish to hang signage, it must be hung in the center of your booth (depth-wise) rather than the back or side, where it will impact your neighboring exhibitor. It must be no more than 14' (we can determine height) to the top of the sign and a minimum 8' (we can determine height) to the bottom of the sign.
- Written permission must be received from Show Management for any exceptions to above regulations. If in doubt of any guidelines it is best to render a drawing of your proposed layout for approval, as we don't want to have a conflict at show site.
- On site at the show, management will request revisions to booths that do not adhere to these regulations.
